

**Amendment to the Examination Regulations for the
postgraduate part-time Master's degree course
International Management & Information Systems - Online
at the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences,
Soest campus**

dated 28 May 2021

In accordance with § 2 (4) and § 64 (1) of the Law governing the universities of the federal state of North Rhine-Westphalia (Higher Education Act) of 16 September 2014 (GV.NRW.P.547) – in the version to amend the Higher Education Act dated 25 March 2021 (GV.NRW.P.331) – and in accordance with § 1 (1) of the General Examination Regulations for Bachelor's and Master's courses at the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences, the Faculty of Electrical Engineering of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences has issued the following regulations:

Article I

The Examination Regulations for the postgraduate part-time Master's degree course International Management & Information Systems – Online at the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences, Soest campus dated 25 April 2019 (public announcement “Amtliche Bekanntmachung der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen – Verkündungsblatt der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen” of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences – as of 15 May 2019) are amended with the following changes:

§ 3 (2) shall be amended by the following letter d:

"d) The obligation to provide proof does not apply to applicants who have acquired their general or subject-linked higher education entrance qualification at a German-speaking institution."

Article II

These regulations will come into effect the day after publication. They are published in the public announcement “Amtliche Bekanntmachung der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen – Verkündungsblatt der Fachhochschule Südwestfalen” of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences.

They are issued, after review by the Rectorate of the South Westphalia University of Applied Sciences, upon decision of the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, dated 26 May 2021.
